Volume of the text is up to 8 A4 pages prepared by **MS Word editor**, **Times New Roman** font, font size **14**, regular letter spacing, single line spacing, paragraph indentation - 10 mm, page parameters - margins of 20 mm, portrait orientation. Width alignment. Paragraph style is normal. The use of auto-transfer is allowed. Figures (format **.jpg** or **.bmp**), charts, tables and formulas are to be stated in the text in compatible with MS Word editors. References in the text are in square brackets. The text of the article should be sent by e-mail in one file with the registration form. The file must be named with the surname of the first author (in Latin letters). The article's UDC, as well as a brief annotation and keywords in Russian and English are to be stated in the text of the article.

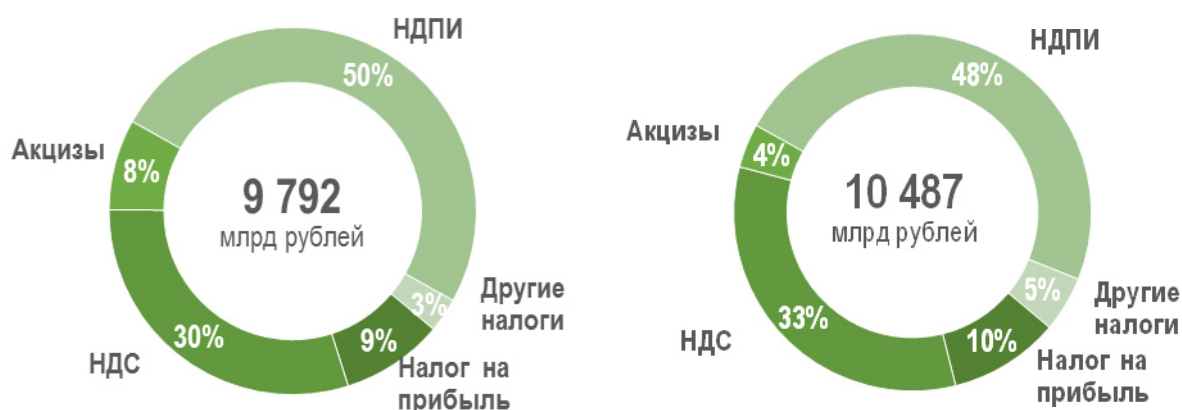


Figure 1. Structure of Federal budget revenues of the Russian Federation in January-October 2018-2019
